- Robust policy recommendations to guide future actions against racism and prejudice.

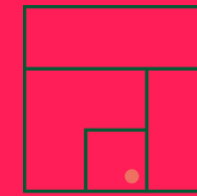
## WHAT

The STOP-RACISM project is an ambitious initiative spanning a period of 24 months and funded under the Erasmus Plus KA2 program.

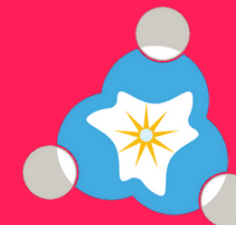
