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### **Field Research**

JULY AND AUGUST 2023

To assess the current level of intercultural literacy in each country, a questionnaire was created for individuals aged 16-35. This questionnaire included questions about their understanding of intercultural literacy, their perceptions of current levels of interculturality, and related topics.

Each partner translated the questionnaire into their local language for participants, while an English version was also available for those unable to use the local language version.

The respondents included 30 participants each from Portugal and Cyprus, 60 from Greece, 35 from Bulgaria, and 40 from Denmark, totaling 195 participants.



## Main findings:

A need for:

- more effective policies, strategies, and action plans
- Robust antiracist campaigns
- Comprehensive training programs
- Regular joint events
- Social, health, and educational services for diverse cultural backgrounds
- Essential for fostering respect for human rights and reducing hate speech



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
