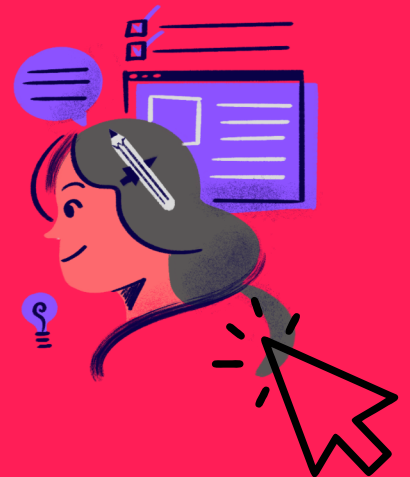
The Final Chapter, but Just the Beginning!

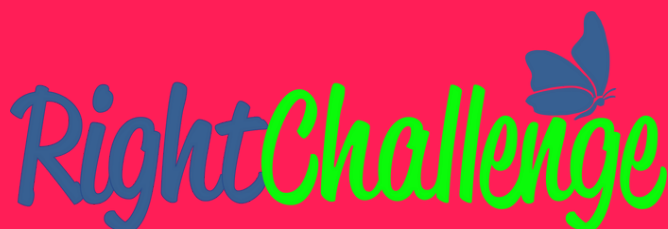
